# BIOSECURITY EXCELLENCE AT PORT OF TAURANGA

Everyone who works in and around the Port plays a part in keeping unwanted pests and diseases out of New Zealand.

Pests and diseases from offshore can cause serious harm to New Zealand's unique environment and primary industries; and the Port of Tauranga is one of many ways in which they can enter.

That's why the Port of Tauranga is working with other key organisations to pursue 'biosecurity excellence at the Port' – an award winning initiative to lift biosecurity protection at the Port and its transitional facilities through a partnership approach between Port staff, associated industries and government.

This partnership explores opportunities to innovate and strengthen the current screening and inspection programmes at the Port of Tauranga and progresses initiatives to reduce biosecurity risks.

This calendar features 12 of our most unwanted pests that could potentially enter through the Port of Tauranga. Our best chance at keeping them out includes surveillance among people who know what to look for and can identify and report these pests, should they arrive.

Transitional facilities and associated industries such as transporters and other logistical organisations can provide vital assistance with this surveillance.

By working together, we can help protect New Zealand's environment and primary industries from unwanted biosecurity risks.
