These are a useful reminder of what to look for when monitoring canopies to determine presence of Psa



*Cane dieback associated with cankers; red exudate associated with previous wounds; exudate on trunks*





*Unbroken buds with rusty colouration indicating Psa infection; collapse of end shoots (where frost is not the cause); unbroken buds at the ends of canes*





*Canopy impacts from frost are varied. This canopy viewed Sunday is less affected than many but still offers several damage points that need to be protected from Psa impacts. Frosted canes similarly will be at risk of infection.*
